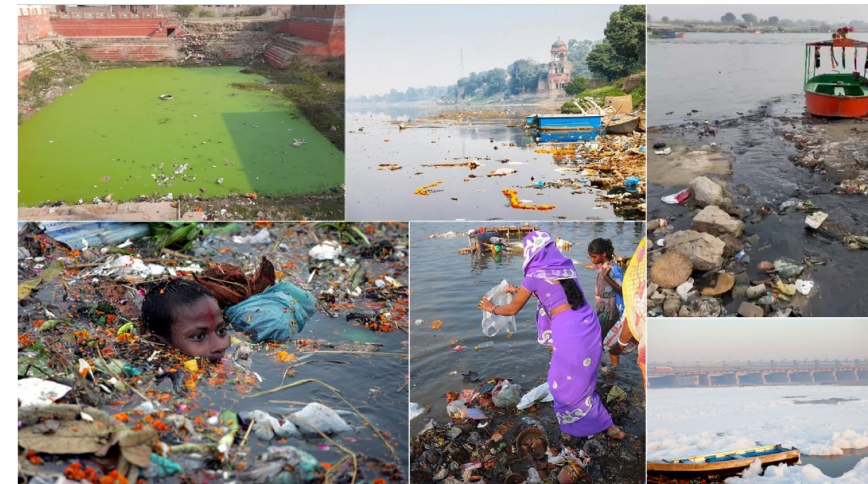

- India is suffering from clean water shortages
- Our water bodies like rivers, wells etc. are heavily polluted

# Our Mission and Ambition for 2026-2029

In the coming years we will initiate 3 new projects:

- 1. Cleanup of the governmentally appointed first 15 miles of the Yamuna River,** along the sacred ghats in Mathura and restoration of water bodies (Kunds & Lakes), funded by CSR corporate funds and family offices,
- 2. Built 50 new Water Cycles Buildings,** providing sustainable Fresh Water, underlying the new aera of pollution cleanup and freshwater appreciation in India,
- 3. Educate & sensitize local schools, communities and government bodies** towards sustainable maintenance of restored water bodies & infrastructure and new clean water facilities built by LPP and locally involved governments & committed Companies.

# OUR WORK SO FAR

## HIMACHAL PRADESH

1st Living Water Cycle Building has been realized at Palpung Sherabling Monastic Seat. It is creating an impact on 300+ children, 1000+ monks who are living there and are receiving pure living water.

## UTTARAKHAND (RISHIKESH)

MOUs signed with Chief Minister on cleaning rivers- Bindal & Rispana. Living Water Cycles Building realized in Rishikesh announcement.



# OUR HOLISTIC APPROACH

The overarching goal is to develop a comprehensive understanding of how entire water bodies can be cleaned by conducting an in-depth project report. This will involve thorough research and analysis, followed by exploring how our existing partners can contribute to the implementation of effective solutions.

Our next 5-year Goals:

- To educate 10 million people on water
- To build 100 such living water cycles buildings
- To rejuvenate water bodies such as Kunds
- To work on cleaning up of Rivers

We have published a book named “Water Springs- Water, The source of Life” which tells us about the sacredness of water. We plan to add the book in the school curriculum to spread awareness about water sources.



Collected water mixed from 18 sacred rivers which was bought together in the purest form by spiritual leaders from around the world. Our objective was to spread awareness on the importance & benefits of sacred water sources by circulating a Living Water Jewel Globally.
